

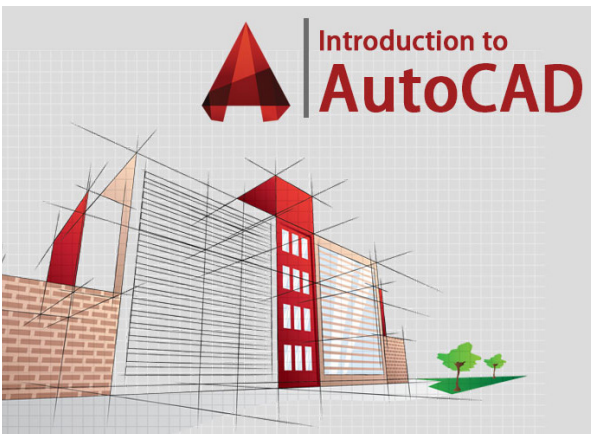
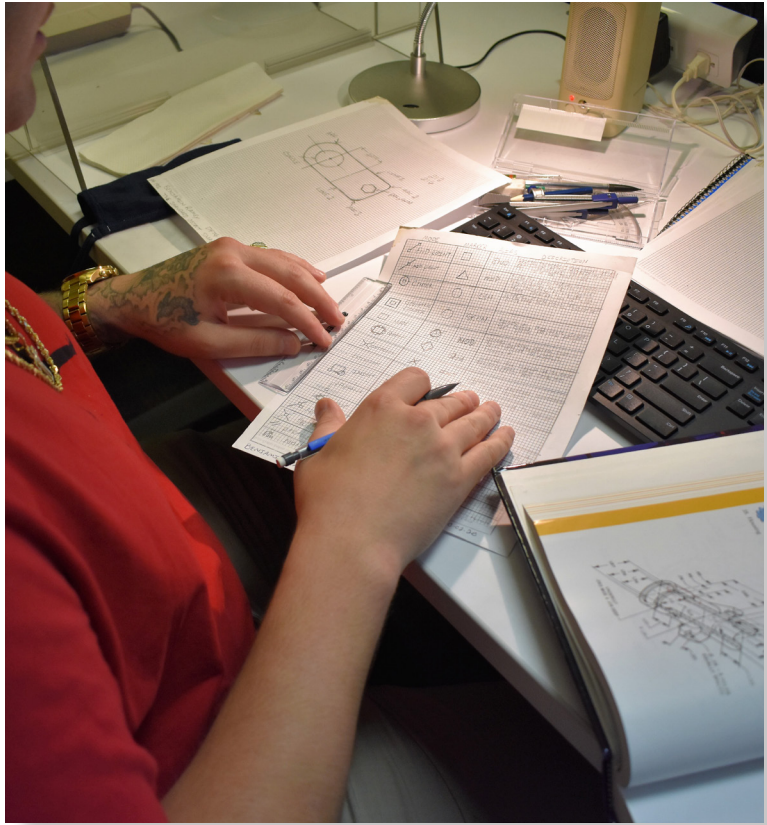


Successful Reentry Programs: GCI Provides Learning, Development and Career Opportunities

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Reentry efforts at the Decatur office are well underway and proving to be worth the time, energy, and support from GCI and its partners. The computer lab at GCI's Decatur office is fully operational and providing residents from GDC's Atlanta Transitional Center the I.T. equipment and support needed to be successful in their AutoCAD® classes with Atlanta Technical College (ATC). The GCI students participate in online classes with other ATC students four days a week and utilize the computer lab for 1 to 1 ½ hours, five days a week, in support of these classes and to complete AutoCAD® class assignments. The dual monitors are a huge benefit in drafting and drawing; and they have helped enable our students to be the top three in both classes.

Thanks to the continuing partnership with GDC's Career and Technical Education unit, Atlanta Transitional Center, the Urban League of Greater Atlanta and Atlanta Technical College, there are three residents currently enrolled in two AutoCAD® Drafting classes with plans to add another resident to the student roster this January. Together, we are making tremendous strides in having a positive and lasting impact on the lives of all Georgians.
